Location of Finals:	Bismarck State College
Award(s):	A performance as soloist with the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony Orchestra on Saturday, April 15, 2023, at the Belle Mehus Auditorium and a cash award of \$500 Additional non-cash / acknowledgement awards may be determined at the judges' discretion.
To Apply:	<ul> <li>Please meet the following requirements for consideration:</li> <li>Submit a completed application form (opposite side)</li> <li>Submit a CD/DVD recording or electronic file of one movement from selected concerto <i>Check to make sure your recording will play properly before submitting.</i></li> <li>Submit a brief resume of your musical and educational history, such as grade level, years of music study, previous prizes/awards, school achievements, and current/past teachers</li> <li>Meet the minimum age requirement – 18 years or younger as of November 5, 2022</li> </ul>
Eligibility:	<ul> <li>Age requirement as noted above</li> <li>Currently enrolled in North Dakota high school, middle school, or home school in one of the following counties in south-central &amp; western North Dakota: <ul> <li>Adams, Billings, Bowman, Burke, Burleigh, Dickey, Divide, Dunn, Eddy, Emmons, Foster, Golden Valley, Grant, Hettinger, Kidder, Lamoure, Logan, McIntosh, McKenzie, McLean, Mercer, Morton, Mountrail, Olivier, Sheridan, Sioux, Slope, Stark, Stutsman, Wells, Williams</li> </ul> </li> <li>Competition is open to the following orchestral instruments: woodwinds, brass, strings, harp, piano, percussion, and classical guitar.</li> <li>The winner of the Junior Division competition will perform with the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony Orchestra at its April 15, 2023 concert in the Belle Mehus Auditorium in Bismarck. The winner must be available for one rehearsal prior to the performance date: the evening of Friday, April 14, 2023. Concert attire is a nice suit or dress. Travel to and accommodation in Bismarck is at the expense of the artist.</li> <li>Past winners are ineligible to compete in the junior division, but may compete in the senior division as long as they meet age requirements.</li> </ul> <li>High school seniors may compete in either the Junior Division <u>OR</u> the Senior Division, but not both.</li>
Repertoire:	<ul> <li>Applicants should perform one movement from a standard concerto for their instrument or a similar work. Orchestral accompaniment must be available for the work. <i>The Bismarck-Mandan Symphony reserves</i> <i>the right to refuse a concerto selection based on its cost or availability. Please call prior to submitting</i> <i>CD recording to confirm if you wish to compete with</i> <u>anything composed after 1900</u>.</li> <li>Ideally, the work should be memorized, if invited to audition in Bismarck. However for Junior Division, this is not a requirement.</li> <li>Maximum length of the solo should not exceed 15 minutes. Minimum length is 4 minutes.</li> <li>After the entry has been received, repertoire changes will not be permitted without the approval of the Music Director of the Bismarck-Mandan Symphony.</li> <li>Contestants must provide their own accompanist. A list of Bismarck-area accompanists is available upon request.</li> </ul>
Application Fee:	A \$25 non-refundable application fee must submitted with preliminary recording and completed application
Judging Decision:	The winner will be announced following the final auditions. All judges' decisions are final.
